

All About Appliqué

During this workshop, we will be working on a sampler of nine different appliqué techniques.

Supply List

- Fabric:
 - 1 m. background fabric *or* 9 squares 10 ½” x 10 ½”
 - 1 m. leaf fabric *or* 10 squares 10” x 10”
 - 0.5 m. flower fabric *or* 10 squares 7” x 7”
 - 0.25 m. flower centre fabric *or* 10 squares 4” x 4”

- 1 m. freezer paper
- 1 m. fusible web
- 1.5 m. water-soluble stabilizer

- Thread:
 - cotton thread to match each fabric
 - basting thread
 - monofilament (invisible) thread
 - *optional*: black cotton thread
 - *optional*: machine embroidery thread to match appliqué fabrics

- Needles, for hand appliqué and basting
- Fabric marking pens or pencils – should be visible on each fabric and removable
- Lead pencil
- Pins
- Scissors
- Glue stick

- Sewing machine with appliqué presser foot

Class Preparation

- Pre-wash fabrics.
- Cut background fabric into nine squares measuring 10 ½” x 10 ½”.
