

Fabric Mosaic

Supply List

*** The following items will be available for purchase in class:**

Freezer Paper	\$0.50 per foot
Lite Steam-A-Seam 2	\$15.00 per meter

A fabric mosaic is created by fusing small pieces of fabric onto a background to create a design. In this workshop, you can make a fabric mosaic butterfly block or a design of your own choice. If you are using your own design, adapt the sizes listed below as necessary.

Fabric

- 16 ½" x 16 ½" square of background fabric

- fabric scraps
 - bring a variety of different colours
 - bring at least five different fabrics in a variety of shades for each colour
 - or just bring your scrap bin!

Other Supplies

- * 12" square of freezer paper (optional)
 - required if you are unable to see through your background fabric to trace the design

- * 1 m. of Lite Steam-A-Seam 2
 - other brands of fusible web will not work with this technique
 - Lite Steam-A-Seam 2 makes the back of the fabric sticky to hold the fabric pieces in place until they are fused

- Scotch tape (for butterfly design)
- pencil and eraser
- fabric markers
- tailor's awl or seam ripper
- small scissors
- 16" x 16" square of Bristol board or cardboard
(optional, for moving block from table to ironing board)
- iron and ironing surface

Note: Sewing machines are not required for this class.
