

Four Fancy Finishes

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In this workshop, four fancy finishes will be demonstrated and explained:

- *Decorative stitching*
- *Piping*
- *Prairie points*
- *Scallops*

The supplies required to complete a 12" x 18" sample of each finish are listed below. Since you will only have time to sew **one or two** samples in class, you may choose to bring only the supplies for the fancy finishes of your choice.

Supplies:

For all finishes:

- Sewing machine, with walking foot
- Rotary cutting supplies
- Pins, scissors

Decorative stitching:

- 12 ½" x 18 ½" piece of quilted fabric, quilted right to the edges
- 2 strips of fabric for binding, 2 ½" x width of fabric
- Decorative thread for top and bobbin
- Sewing machine presser foot for decorative stitching

Piping:

- 12 ½" x 18 ½" piece of quilted fabric, quilted right to the edges
- 2 metres of 1/8" cording
- 2 strips of fabric for piping, 1" x width of fabric
- 2 strips of fabric for binding, 2 ½" x width of fabric
- Sewing machine zipper foot
- Thread to match binding fabric
- Thread to match piping fabric

Prairie Points:

- 12 ½" x 18 ½" piece of quilted fabric, leaving at least 1" unquilted around the edges
- 3 strips of fabric for one-colour prairie points, 2 ½" x width of fabric
- For multi-coloured prairie points, bring extra 2 ½" strips or 40 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares
- Thread to match backing fabric

Scallops:

- 16" x 22" piece of quilted fabric, quilted right to the edges
- 2 strips of fabric for facing (same as backing fabric or matching backing fabric), 2 ½" x width of fabric
- Scallop ruler with 6" scallop (if you have one) or template of scallop below
- Fabric marker
- Thread to match facing fabric
